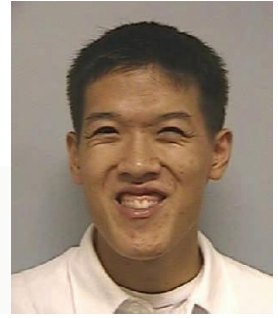

# TAIWAN STM TRIP

Greetings and peace to you! I am writing to tell you about an exciting short term missions (STM) trip I will be embarking on from June 30 – July 15 to Taipei, Taiwan, where I will be working with the Lin Nan church to put on its first-ever Vacation Bible School (VBS) program; and Joel and Judy Linton, a missionary couple involved in church planting and gospel music ministries.

Originally, my team and I from my home church, the Atlanta Chinese Christian Church (ACCC), were planning a three-week trip to Kyrgyzstan to teach English with a missions organization that is currently supported by our church. Unfortunately, that trip was cancelled due to the political instability that has developed there recently. After some prayer and discussion, we decided to pur-

sue another trip to either Taiwan or Guatemala before fortuitously finding a good fit with the STM plans of another area church, the Raleigh Chinese Christian Church (RCCC).

At first, I was a bit reluctant to join what I felt like would be “someone else’s” program. After prayer and meditation, however, God clearly and quickly removed my qualms about partnering with RCCC as He reminded me of the importance of humility and working together as a team rather than alone. The latter lesson was a stark reminder of one of the main lessons I learned while on my STM trip to China (2002) where, more than ever before, I truly felt like I was a part of something greater than myself.

Now, I’m genuinely excited for the opportunity to be a part of

this team (9 RCCC members, 3 ACCC members, and several Lin Nan Church members) and to use my time and gifts for His glory. Our VBS program will involve teaching 100+ youth (ages 10-15) the Gospel message using English Bible stories and fellowshiping with them through various activities. I’m also looking forward to working with the Lintons and getting a taste of church planting work.

I apologize for the short notice, but I humbly ask for your support in finances and prayer by June 24 as outlined below. Also, email recipients of this letter will continue to receive regular updates. Thank you in advance for your support and partnership.
